09 - Purpose of processing

The processing of the data facilitates the selection of peer evaluators. The peer evaluation teams will be composed of candidate evaluators, who have been selected by the Peer Evaluation Committee in accordance with the documents mentioned above (policy, procedure, manual)

In brief; Recognition Bodies nominate candidate peer evaluators with the necessary basic competences and skills to the Peer Evaluation secretariat (at least during the pilot phase provided by the Agency)The Secretariat carries out a check against the criteria. Non-acceptance of candidate evaluators shall be justified.Training of the candidate evaluators and classification into the categories "Team Leader", "Deputy Team Leader", "Evaluator" and "Trainee".The Secretariat of the Peer Evaluation Committee is responsible for ensuring the relevant procedures are followed during this process;The Secretariat write to all candidate Evaluators to inform them of the classification.A list of selected candidate evaluators is produced and stored by the Secretariat. It is published on the EXTRANET working space dedicated for the peer evaluations.Peer Evaluation Teams are put together based on the classification (Team Leader, Deputy Team Leader, Evaluator, Trainee) according to the competences, experience, and the needs of the specific evaluation (e.g. language skills);

All nominations submitted by the Recognition Bodies will be valid until the Recognition Body revokes the nomination or the death of the nominated candidate evaluator.
